

## Resolution \_\_\_\_\_

WHEREAS, the Village of Mineral City and a number of adjacent communities have lost various degrees of their freight and passenger rail service, and

WHEREAS, economic retention and development of the production and consumption sectors are reliant upon access to and the use of telecommunication and transportation modes of the distribution sector, and

WHEREAS, numerous government agencies are tasked with or have vested interests in economic retention and development, and

WHEREAS, the Mineral City Railroad Committee has recommended restoration of select rail rights-of-way, infrastructures, and facilities to provide for freight and passenger rail service once more.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT SOLVED by the Council of Mineral City, Tuscarawas County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Council of Mineral City, Tuscarawas County, Ohio hereby creates the Regional Rail Restoration Steering Committee.

Section 2. Steering Committee membership will be open to elected officials or their designees in Tuscarawas and adjacent counties.

Section 3. The Steering Committee will be hosted by the Mineral City Railroad Committee or by other Steering Committee members.

Section 4. The Steering Committee will explore topics including but not limited to routes, business and governance models, costs, financing, uses, users, stakeholders, etc.

Section 5. The Steering Committee will issue a final report and thereafter may be dissolved by an affirmative vote of its members.
