SUBJECT: Location of Signal Housings at or near Highway
Crossings

In all future installations or relocating signal housings near or next to highway crossings, the attached engineering guidelines will be followed.

The side view of the motorist down the track must be maintained. Therefore, you will have to set the housings away from the crossings and back from the track as far as practical. Each crossing has specific sight requirements, and when staking out the crossing this must be kept in mind.
