~~(A)(1) Except as otherwise provided in division (A)(2) or (3) of this section, the area of jurisdiction of a port authority created in accordance with section 4582.22 of the Revised Code shall include all of the territory required for the designated project or projects of within the political subdivision or subdivisions creating it and, if the port authority ~~owns or leases~~ provides a ~~railroad line or airport transportation,~~ telecommunication, or teleportation project, the territory on which the ~~railroad's line, terminals, and related facilities or the airport's runways,~~ terminals, project's rights of way, infrastructures, and related facilities are located, regardless of whether the territory is located in the political subdivision or subdivisions creating or joining the port authority.~~

Restricts the default port authority jurisdiction from the territory of the creating and joining political subdivisions to project/s jurisdiction/s. Adds jurisdiction on transportation, telecommunication, or teleportation projects to areas beyond creating or joining political subdivision/s territories if necessary.

~~(2) A municipal corporation with a population of at least one hundred thousand according to the most recent federal decennial census may create a port authority within a county that previously created an existing port authority, if the municipal corporation did not join with the county in creating the port authority or thereafter join that port authority. The newly created port authority and the previously created and existing port authority shall possess concurrent jurisdiction over any territory within the jurisdiction of both.~~

~~(3) A county may create a port authority the area of jurisdiction of which excludes any territory that is located in that county and is in the area of jurisdiction of any port authority created in accordance with section 4582.02 or 4582.22 of the Revised Code that is then existing in the county.~~

~~(B)(1) Except as provided in division (B)(2) or (3) of this section, a A political subdivision that has created a port authority or joined an existing port authority shall not be included within any other port authority's equivalent project jurisdictions, unless the port authority contracts or joins with another port authority in accordance with sections 4582.43 and 4582.431 of the Revised Code for one or more equivalent projects, whereupon the combined port authorities and their political subdivisions that created or joined with them shall all be included within the same project jurisdiction.~~

Political subdivisions joining port authorities per established project jurisdictions cannot be a part of another port authority project jurisdiction unless the two port authorities agree to jointly administer the same project/s.

~~(2) A municipal corporation with a population of less than one hundred thousand according to the most recent federal decennial census that has joined an existing port authority in a county with a population of five hundred thousand or less may create a port authority within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipal corporation.~~

Eliminated as proposed changes revise port authority creation and joining rules.

~~(3) A municipal corporation and a county jointly may create a new port authority if both of the following apply:~~

~~(a) The municipal corporation created a port authority after July 9, 1982, and that port authority operates an airport;~~

~~(b) The county joined a port authority after July 9, 1982, and that port authority operated an airport.~~
